As per Sub para 4(d)(i) to Para-7 of GoI DOPT OM No.3/3/2016-Estt(Pay-II) dated 1st May 2017, “In the case of ex-servicemen (retiring before attaining the age of 55 years) who held post below commissioned officer rank in the Defence Forces and in the case of civilians who held posts below Group ‘A’ at the time of their retirement, the entire pension and the pension equivalent retirement benefits shall be ignored”.

The last pay protection (after ignoring the pension element) is already in vogue for re-employed ex-combatant clerks who joined as Junior level clerk in Taxation Department through SSC examination.
