2. The meeting began at 3.30 pm with the welcome words by the co-ordinator of the meeting Sri R.S.R.Murthy, ITO(HQ)(Welfare) after a brief registration process. The items of agenda for the meeting were as under:

- i) Change of Chairmanship
- ii) Finalisation of Holidays to be observed in 2016 in AP & TS
- iii) Any other issue with the permission of the Chair.

3. Welcoming the gathering, the Hon'ble Chairman Shri I.Suresh Babu noted that only a few members attended the meeting. Members replied that meeting was being conducted once a year that too for only finalization of Holidays. The Chairman recollected the days of 1980s when the meetings were conducted at regular intervals and Cultural / Sports events used to be organised. Members from Airports Authority also shared similar feelings and stated that they would be looking forward to have a better coordination in future.

4. After formal acceptance of change of Chairmanship of CGEWCC by all the members, Sri RSR Murthy, co-ordinator made a power point presentation with regard to holidays to be observed in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

4.1 Department of Personnel and Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Government of India notified vide letter dated 11th June 2015 fourteen holidays as compulsory closed holidays to be observed in 2016 and three holidays that could be chosen out of a list of holidays given separately under para 3.2. The committee had decided the following three holidays to be observed as compulsory closed holidays in 2016.

Pongal (Sankranti)	-	15 th January	(Friday)
Ugadi	-	8 th April	(Friday)
Vinayaka Chaviti	-	5 th September	(Monday)

4.2. Three more festivals specific to the states of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana were decided to be added to the list of Restricted Holidays in view of the local importance of the festivals i.e.

Bonalu	-	1 st August	(Monday)
Varalakshmi Vratham	-	12 th August	(Friday)
Bathukamma	-	3 rd October	(Monday)

4.3. In case of any alternation of the above mentioned restricted holidays by the State Government of AP or TS, such alteration would be considered by the Chairman, CGEWCC. Further, the committee decided that the festivals remaining after determining three compulsory holidays mentioned at para 3.2 of DOPT's letter should be added to the list of restricted holidays.

5. The final list of closed holidays to be observed in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana during the calendar year 2016 is given as annexure-I. List of Restricted holidays is given as annexure-II

6. Finally, the Hon'ble Chairman made his concluding remarks by reiterating his keen interest in conducting Inter-Departmental Cultural / Sports events on the same lines as that of CRSB. It was conveyed that a separate meeting would be convened in this regard. The date, time and venue would be intimated in due course.

7. The co-ordinator informed that all future communications /circulars in respect of CGEWCC/RSB would be uploaded on www.incometaxhyderabad.org and correspondence would be made through email rsbhyderabad2015@gmail.com. All the members /representatives of various departments present at the meeting accepted paperless communication. It was also requested that all the HODs may send their email address and contact numbers to the said email.

8. Shri R.S.R.Murthy, Income-tax Officer (Hqrs)(Welfare) has been designated as Additional Secretary, CGEWCC.


