

Sub: CBDT Badminton Tournament at Bengaluru on 03.03.2023 & 04.03.2023
– Selection trials for AP & TS Region Income Tax Team – Reg.

The CBDT Badminton tournament for officers & officials (excluding officials recruited through sports quota for Badminton) is being conducted by the CBDT Sports & Cultural Committee (CBDT SCC) which is scheduled to be held at Bengaluru, Karnataka from 03.03.2023 to 04.03.2023.

RULES OF THE EVENT (BADMINTON)

- (i) The badminton matches shall be carried out in 2 broad categories namely, officers' category and officials' category. These are further divided into various age categories as under:

OFFICERS CATEGORY (ITO and above rank officers)	OFFICIALS CATEGORY (all officials)
1. Gentlemen officers open Singles/doubles	1. Gentlemen officials open Singles/doubles
2. Gentlemen officers 40+ Singles/doubles	2. Gentlemen officials 45+ Singles/doubles
3. Gentlemen officers 55+ Singles/doubles	3. Women officials' open singles
4. Women officers open Singles/doubles	4. Women officials 45+ doubles
5. Women officers 45+ Singles/doubles	5. Mixed doubles open
6. Mixed doubles open	6. Mixed doubles 45+
7. Mixed double 45+	

- (i) Each participant can participate in **not more than three events** (including both singles and doubles) irrespective of the age categories.
- (ii) Each CCA region shall nominate **not more than 12 players** (including officers and officials). With respect to Delhi region and Mumbai region, the number of nominations (including officers and officials) shall not exceed 20 and 18 respectively.
- (iii) Each CCA region should **not have more than 2 entries for one particular event**. In case of Delhi and Mumbai the ceiling is 3 entries. It is also advised that the team should be constituted in such a way that there is proper representation of officers and officials.

- (iv) *If there is paucity of players in any region (hereafter referred as deficit region) and it is not able to form requisite number of teams in doubles or mixed doubles categories, then available players of that deficit region may choose partners from any other region. But such partner should not already be part of his or her own region. The names of the said grouping/team should be intimated through office of Pr.CCA of deficit region by the due date. The name of the partner needs to be mentioned in the nominations forwarded by the PrCCAs/ cadre controlling authorities.*
- (v) *Officers and officials should not team up with each other as they will not fall under any of the prescribed categories above.*
- (vi) *The nominations should be sent by the Pr CCAs/ Cadre controlling office to the email id in the prescribed format by 8 pm on 28.02.2023. Late entries will strictly not be entertained. The filled form, in the case of doubles/mixed double event, should clearly specify the name of the partner. The name of the partner will not be allowed to be changed later. Further, the entries sent without the recommendation of Cadre controlling authority will not be entertained.*

- (vii) *In case the number of entries in a particular category is very less, then the organizing committee reserves the right to consider cancelling the event and the same shall be informed before the tournament.*

(viii) *The number of points in each round will vary depending upon the rounds of the event. The rules will be adopted from the latest BWF rules followed. The rules decided by the organizing committee shall be final and binding.*

(ix) *The age as on 1st Feb 2023 will be considered for eligibility criteria in any event category.*

(x) *The tournament draws and fixtures will be made available to the participants on 02/03/2023.*

(xi) *All participants are required to be present on 03/02/2023, 8.00 a.m. sharp at the Karnataka Badminton Association (KBA), No.4 Jasma Bhavan Road, Millers Tank Bund Road, Vasanth Nagar, Bengaluru – 560052. The QR code for location is*

(xii) *Considering the schedule and the time frame, it is the duty of the players to keep in touch with the organizers for the schedule and reporting time. It has been decided by the organizing committee that if a participant fails to report by the given scheduled match time, walkover will be granted to the opponent who is present.*


(xiii) *The players should wear non-marking (but not black Sole) shoes in the court.*

(xiv) *For this tournament, participants will be provided AS-30 Shuttles.*

(xv) *All players have to get their own sports gear.*

(xvi) *In case of any dispute, the dispute resolution committee will decide the issue. The committee's decision shall be final and binding.*

(xvii) *Since the participation in the event will be treated as an official tour, the participants are requested to make their own boarding and lodging arrangements. However, on request basis, local administration can provide assistance in finding suitable boarding and lodging arrangements.*
