Sub : Filling up the post of Dy.Superintendent of Police on deputation
(Including Short Term Contract) basis in Central Bureau of

CBI intends to induct suitable officers to work as Dy. Superintendents of Police holding General Central Service Group A/Gazetted(Non- Ministerial) in CBI in the Pay level-10 of pay matrix (pre-revised PB-3) Rs.15,600-39,100 + Grade Pay of Rs.5,400/-) on deputation (including Short Term Contract) basis.

The CBI offers very challenging and professionally satisfying environment to DSPs who would get an opportunity to investigate important cases of anti-corruption and other cases referred by the higher Courts and Governments.The Deputy Superintendent of Police will investigate/enquire into the cases which are allotted to him/her. In branches where there is no Additional SP, one of the Dy.SP will assist the Superintendent of Police in supervision of the work relating to administration, establishment/accounts and designated as Dy.SP(H.Qrs.). In this respect he will perform such functions and duties as are allotted to him/her by the Superintendent of Police.

Eligibility criteria as per CBI Recruitment Rules, 2013 (Annexure-I) for induction as DSPs is as follows :

- 1) The officer must possess a Bachelor's degree from a Recognised University.
- 2) (a) Officers holding analogous post(DSPs) in Central Police Organisations on regular basis (OR) with 6 years regular service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in posts in the pay band-2 of Rs.9,300-34,800 plus grade pay of Rs.4,600 or equivalent, in the parent cadre or department.

(b) Officers holding analogous post(DSPs) in State Police Organisations on regular basis (OR) with 6 years regular service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in posts in the pay band-2 of Rs.9,300-34,800 plus grade pay of Rs.4,600 or equivalent, in the parent cadre or department

(c) Officers holding analogous post on regular basis in Central Excise and customs of Income Tax or persons or persons working under Central Government or State Government or Public sector undertakings (OR) with 6 years regular service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in posts in the pay band-2 of Rs.9,300-34,800 plus grade pay of Rs.4,600 or equivalent, in the parent cadre or department.

3) Three years experience in Enquiry or Intelligence Investigation work in case of Central Police Officers , three years experience in investigation of criminal cases in case of State Police Officers and Five Years experience in vigilance or investigation or intelligence work in case of officers from Central Excise, Customs, Income Tax and other Central Government or State Government or Public sector undertakings

4) Period of deputation including period of deputation in another Ex-cadre Post immediately preceding the appointment in the same or some other Organisation/Dept. Of Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years.

5) The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation/absorption shall not be exceeding 56 years.

In this connection it is requested that the applications of willing and suitable officers who can be spared immediately should be accompanied with (i) cadre clearance (ii) bio-date(in duplicate) as in the pro-forma enclosed (Annexure-II) (iii) Attested (on each page with Clearance (v) Integrity Certificate and (vi) Statement giving details of major or minor penalties imposed on the officer, if any, during the last 10 years.


The officers coming on deputation to CBI or entitled for the following additional benefits :

- 1) Considerable increase in their monthly pay by way of SPECIAL INCENTIVE ALLOWANCE @ 20% of basic pay .
- 2) One All India LTC (Visiting any Place in India) and one Home Town LTC to Self and family members for every four year Block.
- 3) CGHS (Central Govt. Health Scheme) facility.
- 4) Benevolent fund relief/Loan for the employee's children in case of prosecuting higher studies, getting married, etc.
- 5) Training on various topics being organised by the CBI Academy and other depts.
- 6) Journey by Air on Official Journeys as well as LTC.
