

3. Accordingly, all the Pr. CCITS/DGITs are hereby directed to complete the process of registration of the DDOs in their Zone immediately and also furnish a detail report of the same for furnishing it to the DoP&PW.

Minutes of the meeting held on 29/03/2017 at 03.00 P.M with the representatives of 7
Ministries /Department on the implementation of Bhavishya

DoP&PW had conducted a meeting on 29.03.2017 with the representatives of 7 Ministries/Department about the implementation of Bhavishya under the Chairpersonship of Additional Secretary, DOP&PW.

2. **The list of participants is at Annexure -I.**

3. Additional Secretary, DoP&PW in her address stated that necessity of review meeting is felt as Bhavishya has been made mandatory in all Ministries/Departments with effect from 01.01.2017. She also stressed that all authorities must strictly follow the timelines prescribed under the CCS(Pension) Rules and in no case will pension cases be delayed.

4. While reviewing the status in CPWD under M/o Urban Development, it was observed that all DDOs are registered under Bhavishya and all pension cases are being processed through Bhavishya. Pendency has been reduced under category "Retired but PPO not issued". CCA, M/o UD is regularly conducting Review meetings with the concerned PAOs of M/O UD on the status of implementation of Bhavishya in M/o UD. Additional Secretary appreciated the good work done by CPWD and CCA M/o UD in successful implementation of Bhavishya.

5. CPWD made the following suggestions to improve the monitoring process :

- i) To create a flag for the provisional pension cases in overall pending cases to get a clearer picture of actual pendency at Nodal Officer level.
- ii) A report may be developed on status of pension cases with reference to a specific retirement date. An e-mail alert be sent to Nodal Officer on regular basis showing the pendency.
- iii) In old cases where PPOs have already been generated upto 01.01.2017, Nodal Officer may be given access in Bhavishya system to upload the PPO number.

Additional Secretary stated that all the suggestions given by CPWD are useful and directed NIC to incorporate it in the Bhavishya system.

6. During review of CDBT and CBEC under D/o Revenue it is seen that 738 DDOs and 425 DDOs are yet to be registered out of total 1584 DDOs and 1179 DDOs respectively. Additional Secretary directed to complete the registration process within 30 days and also ensure that no case is being processed manually.

7. With regard to M/o Mines, 27 DDOs of Geological Survey of India are yet to be registered out of total 98 DDOs. Representative of M/o Mines assured that the process of registration of DDOs will be completed within 10 days.

8. Process of registration of DDOs in D/O Technology and M/o Water Resources is almost complete - only 1 DDO and 3 DDOs are yet to be registered in D/o Science & Technology and M/o Water Resources respectively. Additional Secretary also appreciated the efforts made by D/o Science & Technology and M/o Water Resources in completing the process of registration of DDOs in Bhavishya. Additional Secretary has also desired that Nodal Officer of both the Department may ensure regular uploading of retiree data by all DDOs in their Department to have a overall retiree position at a glance.

9. D/o Health & Family Welfare has also assured that they will liaise with DGHS to get registration in Bhavishya for their remaining 31 DDOs and process the pension case through Bhavishya only.

10. The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
